Submissions to the Minister Under s. 43, 44 and 46 of the

Extradition Act, 1999

I reviewed your "Summary" once again and noticed two points in your Memorandum to the Minister of April 25th that I thought I should write to you about.

Firstly, on page 7, item "c", Violation of the Harm principle, it seems to me that the Minister should know that Malmo-Levine, Caine and Clay are both pending in the Supreme Court of Canada and were to be heard in June, but the cases have been traversed to the fall sitting of the Court. All three cases are going to be heard together.

Secondly, o page 10, in your second to last paragraph, you make reference to two letters urging that Ms. Boje be sent back to the United States. One makes specific allegations about Ms. Boje, attributing statements to her, which are not admitted but denied. Would it be possible to obtain copies of those two letters so that we might be apprised of the case made by those correspondents against her, and in order that we might have a fair opportunity to respond to them, if we consider a response to be necessary?
